- Graduate: \$25,947: Full-time for 3 semesters

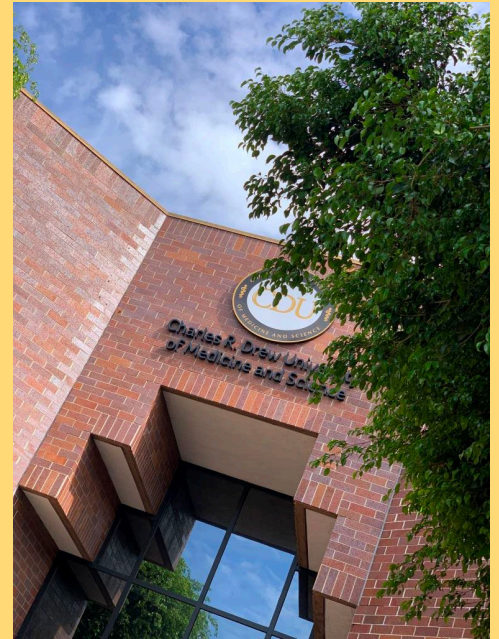
