In 2020, Charles R. Drew University of Medicine and Science (CDU) operations generated more than \$100 million in impact to California, \$90 million to Los Angeles County, and \$72 million in SPA 6.

Tripp Umbach estimates that for every dollar in 2020 that the state provided to CDU, \$14.29 was added to the economy resulting from CDU operations.

When workforce and other social benefits are added, the total economic benefit of the university to the state of California in 2020 equals \$215 million, resulting in \$30.71 being added to the economy for every dollar provided to CDU by the state.

The new 100,000-square-foot Health Professional Education Building will generate a total economic impact of \$208.8 million on the California economy, \$179.5 million on Los Angeles County, and \$143.6 million on SPA 6.
