#### **POLICY STATEMENT**

Charles R. Drew University of Medicine and Science College of Medicine MD Program ensures that a narrative description of a medical student's performance, including his or her non-cognitive achievement, is included as a component of the assessment in each required course and clerkship of the medical education program.

## **PROCEDURES**

Courses or clerkships that contain longitudinal student groups and/or laboratory experiences where student groups (with fewer than 20 students) have the same facilitator for at least four sessions should provide all students with a narrative assessment of his/her performance.

### **DEFINITIONS**

Narrative assessment: Written comments from faculty that assess student performance and achievement in meeting the objectives of a course or clerkship. (LCME)
